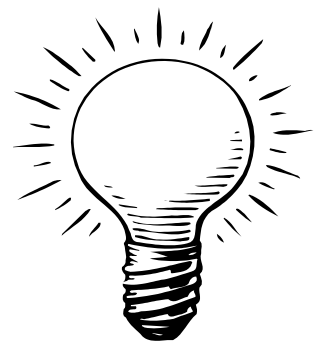

THE GREAT RECESSION AND THE FORECLOSURE CRISIS

The Great Recession and foreclosure crisis have led to historically high levels of job and home displacement. A team of researchers from the Department of Sociology at The Ohio State University, with the help of Homeport, is studying how the Great Recession and foreclosure crisis have affected individuals' daily lives.
